DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Heat Detection

The cow should be clean and dry before applying paint. Shake can well and then spray a strip 15cm (6 inches) long and 5cm (2 inches) wide along the spine from the head of the tail. Spray against the lay of the hair. Rubbing or removal of the paint patch indicates oestrous activity.

Do NOT use on sheep.

Store below 49°C. Do not store in direct sunlight.

MATING MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

For efficient management of a herd's reproduction program it is suggested that farmers use this colour coded system commonly used on dairy farms: 1. Red. Paint cows red after they have calved to indicate the cow has started to cycle again. Cows that have not cycled can be identified for veterinary attention.

2. Green. Paint cows green immediately before beginning an AI program to identify cows that come into heat and are ready for insemination.

3. Blue. Paint cows blue immediately after insemination. This shows the cows that have been inseminated.

4. Yellow. Paint cows yellow that have been confirmed pregnant.

CATTLE IDENTIFICATION

Use Red paint for the cows that have a withholding period due to treatment with drugs. Use Green paint for cows that are clear of their withholding period.

Note: Other colour choices may be preferred such as Blue, Orange, Pink or Yellow due to colour blindness or visibility issues on particular cattle breeds.
